25 regions/clusters/research infrastructures will have the opportunity to present their good practices on synergies between clusters and research infrastructures.

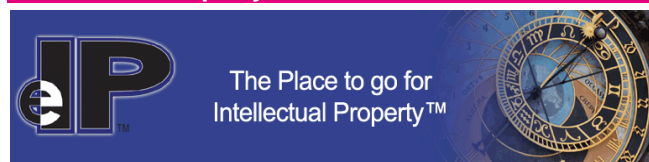
