1. **The Engine Rotating Internal Combustion"(ERIC) type RADAN** have the main features:

- Maximum specific fuel consumption; Cs = 0,100 Kg/Kwh at Diesel Motors and 0,110 Kg/kWh at gasoline motors
- Effective output more than 70%
- ENERGY BALANCE OF RADAN MOTOR:

$$Q = Q_e + Q_r + Q_g + Q_{inc} + Q_{rez}$$

$$\% \quad 100 \quad 70 \quad - \quad 15 \quad 3 \quad 12$$

in which:

Q_e : heat flow, equivalent work mechanic (L_m) made; Q_r : idem, lost by forced cooling (removed);

Q_g : idem, lost in exhaust gases; Q_{inc} : idem, equivalent of incomplete fuel combustion;

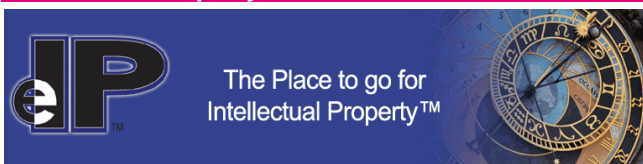

Future Internet PPP launched

The first phase of the Public Private Partnership on the Future Internet (FI-PPP) has been formally launched by the EC. The first phase of the FI-PPP is the launch of one core platform (FI-WARE) in which there are eight case projects. The projects were selected from an initial call.

FI-WARE will develop a set of core platform tools in order to prepare for a large-scale trial of innovative and complex internet services and applications in a wide range of domains across Europe.

The eight case projects will each be exploring and developing future internet services in a different area; for example, environmental data in the public domain, international logistics value-chains, networked media and personal mobility. In total, 152 organisations have signed up to participate in the FI-PPP. Private companies, research organisations and the public sector have committed to match the EC's €90 million total funding for the first phase of the programme.

The FI-PPP aims to advance Europe's competitiveness in internet technologies and systems, by developing new technologies, services and business models for the internet of the future.

Green light for Danube Strategy

Member States' ministers for EU affairs adopted the Council's conclusions on the Danube Region Strategy.

The Danube region covers parts of 8 EU countries and 6 non-EU countries. The region is facing several challenges:

- environmental threats (water pollution, floods, climate change)
