

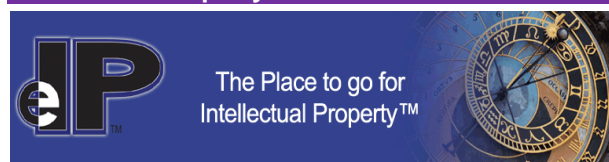

Scientific data: open access to research results will boost Europe's innovation capacity

The EC outlined measures to improve access to scientific information produced in EU. Broader, more rapid access to scientific papers, data will make it easier for researchers & businesses to build on the findings of public-funded research. This will boost EU's innovation capacity and give citizens quicker access to the benefits of scientific discoveries. In this way, it will give Europe a better return on its €87 billion annual investment in R&D. The measures complement the Commission's Communication to achieve a European Research Area (ERA), also adopted.

European Commission targets barriers to Single Market for research and innovation

The EC has set out concrete steps Member States should take to achieve the EU Research Area (ERA), a Single Market for research & innovation in EU. The goal is to enable researchers, research institutions, businesses to better move, compete, co-operate across borders. This will strengthen Member States' research bases increase their competitiveness, allow them to work together more effectively to tackle major societal challenges, such as climate change, food and energy security, public health. To help achieve the ERA, the EC has also signed a Joint Statement and Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with organisations representing key research organisations and research funding bodies. The proposals are a response to the deadline set by EU leaders to make the European Research Area a reality by 2014.

Are you creative or innovative? What's the difference?

A definition of creativity: A process that results in a novel work that is accepted as useful by a significant group of people at some point in time-Stein, 1974. A definition of Innovation: Implementing something new that adds value or quantifiable gain, which requires many skill sets, usually a team - Horth&Vehar, 2012. The key differences are that 1) innovation is about implementation (which is not required by creativity), 2) usually requires a team.

I believe that there are numerous qualities you need to have in order to "create" "innovations": observe, listen, question, motivate your environment to participate and be courageous to say "why not". I believe in concentrating on creativity, but there needs to be a great team in place to innovate/implement the creation. The team needs to understand the direction of creative thinking and actually developing it into I&I.

What about when we talk about little 'c' or in other words incremental creativity? The boundary between creative & innovative behaviors is very loose, as idea generation/implementation mostly happens simultaneously. For instance, think about someone who finds a new way to communicate product value to customers, then he/she goes/experiments with those ideas by implementing them.

You ask: "So as a leader, which do you focus on, creativity or innovation? And how do you know the difference?" The answer is BOTH. This is the reason why within a team you need persons with complementary traits, as from "Foursights" <http://www.foursightonline.com/>. Tests are available to "label" person for generating creative ideas of implementing them.

New EIP showcases cities of the future

The EC has launched the **EU Innovation Partnership (EIP) on Smart Cities & Communities (SCC)**. It is the 5th of its kind after the pilot EIP on 'Active and Healthy ageing' and those on 'Raw Materials', 'Agriculture' and 'Water'.

EIPs are platforms, which are created to reinforce the coherence of European research and innovation priorities and help focus, streamline and simplify policy actions, while pointing to measures to bridge gaps and accelerate the uptake of innovations. They **do not supersede or replace other existing initiatives or instruments**, nor are they a substitute for existing institutional decision-making mechanisms.

EIPs constitute one of 34 action points the EC has committed to in order to reach the targets set for the Europe 2020 Flagship Initiative 'Innovation Union'. Most importantly EIPs are based on **using & linking existing knowledge, actions, funding** rather than 're-inventing the wheel'.
